Busselton Jetty brings marine science and conservation education to your school with an exciting new virtual program, live-streamed directly to your classroom!

Your experience will begin with a live stream from the Underwater Observatory, including a guided tour and question period. Afterwards, use the provided PDF Teacher Guide to select curriculum-linked activities and resources to explore with your classroom. Busselton Jetty staff member will follow up with an optional 15 minute video call to your classroom to discuss your class learning.

Two Virtual Excursion Options:

Vertical Reef Biodiversity *(All year levels)*

Travel 8m from the water's surface to the seafloor of Geographe Bay. Learn all about marine zonation and how water depth influences marine communities.

Human Impact *(Recommended years 6 and above)*

Explore how human actions impact marine life, and how individuals can take action to protect oceans worldwide.
